Tailored specifically to Translink, the apprenticeship programme is a work based NVQ motor industry qualification covering bus and coach engineering maintenance. The programme ensures Translink get a highly skilled workforce, with technicians trained to Translink's specific requirements.

Students completing this apprenticeship work 4 days a week in Translink with 1 day per week spent in college.
