Course Levels Explained

Thinking of studying higher education at SRC? Where do you begin your journey?

Navigating the world of higher education can feel daunting, but understanding your options is the first step towards choosing the right course. At Southern Regional College, you'll find more flexibility and choice than ever before.

Unlike university, most students at SRC begin their higher education journey at level 5, studying for a Higher National Diploma (HND) or a Foundation Degree. From there, you can:

- **Progress to level 6 to complete a full honours degree at the College;**

- **Graduate after your level 5 with a recognised qualification which will help you kick start your career; or**
- **Apply to a university of your choice to top-up to an honours degree.**

Our higher education courses are built with flexibility in mind. If you start as a higher level apprentice and your circumstances change, you can easily switch to the part-time study route of the same course and when you're back in employment, return to your apprenticeship pathway. The same flexibility applies in reverse, allowing you to adapt as your career evolves.

The table below shows how each qualification fits within the higher education framework, helping you identify the right entry point to achieve your goals.

Money Matters

Higher education doesn't have to be expensive. Our tuition fees are much less than university. So, you'll graduate with the same qualification, with less debt or no debt. Your course might be made up of tuition fees and other associated costs, such as exam fees or awarding body fees. We are completely upfront about all costs as no one likes these kinds of surprises. Tuition Fees

Full-Time Higher Education Students

Tuition fees for higher education (HE) full-time courses are set by the Department for Economy (DfE) and are currently £2,980 per year*.

Fees may be changed by DfE, and if this happens, we'll publish updates on our website as soon as possible.

Part-Time Higher Education

Tuition fees for part-time students are calculated on an hourly rate. You'll find this information on each individual course page on our website. Just remember, these fees will be less than the full-time rate as they are studied over a longer period of time.

All Students

Full fees must be paid on enrolment, unless you're in receipt of an 'Award Notice' from Student Finance. Any fees paid but subsequently funded by loans from the Student Loans Company or grants from the Education Authority, will be refunded to you.

Get ahead and make your application to Student Finance now and find out what maintenance grant/loan and tuition fee loan are available. Applications for student finance usually open in May for those planning to study from September onwards.

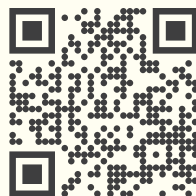
