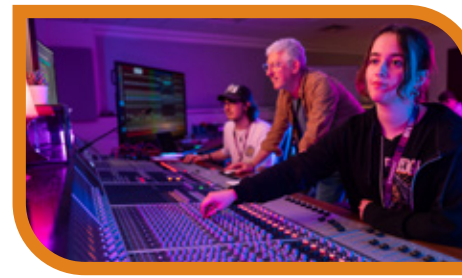

Matthew brings home a Bronze Medal in SkillBuild National Finals

SRC Bricklaying student Matthew Carswell was one of five students from Northern Ireland to take home a medal at the 2024 SkillBuild National Finals in Milton Keynes. The national competition ran from 19-21 November in the Marshall Arena in Milton Keynes and attracted thousands of spectators.

Across three days, competitors were tasked with constructing a project designed by an expert panel of judges, within an 18-hour timeframe. The project tested knowledge and skills, as well as the ability to work under pressure whilst managing time constraints.

To make it to the finals, Matthew was one of the top eight highest scoring competitors across all regional qualifiers in the UK. Techniques Matthew was required to demonstrate in the finals included a firm



understanding of detailed drawings, making use of the various contrasting brickwork, measuring and cutting bricks accurately and to the required sizes, and ensuring limited wastage of materials.

Many hours of training and hard work went into this achievement with lecturer Stephen Chapman commenting: "Matthew's performance at the SkillBuild National Finals was outstanding. Throughout the competition, he demonstrated remarkable focus and composure, maintaining a calm and collected approach from start to finish."

Ebony's a 'cut above the rest' at Apprentice of the Year Awards

Ebony Murtagh, an outstanding butchery apprentice from Portadown was crowned Apprentice of the Year at the Department for the Economy's 2025 Apprenticeship Awards in March 2025.

During her school years, Ebony worked part-time at the deli counter at W&M Farm Meats and returned to the business full time after finishing secondary school. Ebony was assigned to work within the butchery department and quickly began to develop a passion for working with meats which led her to re-consider her education.

Since then, Ebony has gained several qualifications with Southern Regional College including her Level 2 Meat & Poultry and Level 3 in Food Management. Ebony commented: "Since studying at Southern Regional College and working in the butchery industry, I've gained a lot of valuable skills and knowledge, both practical and theoretical. I didn't realise there was so much theory behind butchery; it's about learning fat coverage, lean percentage, understanding the grading system of meat, and

working out profitability by calculating weights and prices for cuts. It's not just about the cuts. There's also a lot of focus on the legal side of things, such as food safety and hygiene."

Speaking on Ebony's success, Micheal Prunty, Butchery Lecturer at Southern Regional College added: "As a female in butchery, Ebony has shown incredible resilience, breaking down barriers and setting an example for others to follow. She is proof that with the right guidance, qualifications, and drive, anyone can excel, regardless of gender or background."

Supporting Your Journey: Financial Services to Help You Succeed at College



At Southern Regional College we believe that finance should not be a barrier to learning. The great news is that there is more help available than ever before to finance your journey in education.

Help For Part-Time Accredited Courses

Having difficulty in paying fees? Did you know that if you are enrolling on a part-time course with a qualification, you may be eligible to receive up to 50% discount on tuition fees?

SRC offers tuition fee discount to students who are in receipt of any of the benefits listed below. If you are the dependent or spouse/partner of a person in receipt of these benefits, you may also be entitled to a discount on tuition fees.

- Guaranteed Pension Credit
- Housing Benefit (Rates Rebate) or Rate Relief
- Income-Based Employment and Support Allowance
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Republic of Ireland Means Tested Benefits
- Universal Credit (within qualifying threshold)

The concession fee payable will be a minimum of £40 and all exam/material fees must be paid in addition to the concession fee.

Other Funding

We want you to enjoy and make the most of your time at SRC. If your part-time course is accredited*, there are several funds available which you can apply to. These can help you pay for course fees, travel, books, childcare or living expenses.

1. Hardship Fund

To apply to the Hardship Fund, you must be 18 years or older and enrolled on a part-time accredited* course. The level of funding provided will be based on household income thresholds. Students on means tested benefits may be entitled to a repayment of the full course fees paid. Students with income below £33,950, may be entitled to a repayment of at least 50% of course fees paid. Application forms for the Hardship Fund will be available at campus receptions from the start of September 2025.

2. Further Education (FE) Grant

Students who are 19 years old by 1st July 2025, who are on a low income or in receipt of a means tested benefit, can apply for a Further Education Grant to help pay for course fees.

Courses eligible must be more than 8 hours per week or have a full-time equivalent programme. Students must also be progressing to a more advanced level of study. You may also receive a grant of £265 for books and equipment. This grant is also means tested. Application forms are available from campus receptions or can be downloaded from www.eani.org.uk/fegrants. Please note the closing date for the FE Grant is the end of October 2025.

3. Student Loan Company: Higher Education Grant and Loan

a) Tuition Fee and Maintenance Grant

Higher Education students can apply for a means tested Maintenance Grant (non-repayable) up to £3,475 for a full-time student or up to £1,230 for a part-time student. Students who do not qualify for a full Tuition Fee Grant, can apply for the outstanding fee via the Tuition Fee Loan option.

b) Tuition Fee Loan

Students can also apply for Tuition and Maintenance Loans which are non-means tested but are repayable. The amount of loan varies; however, a full-time student can receive up to £6,282 per year living away from home and £4,450 per year living at home. A part-time student can receive up to 3,641.25. Students who already hold a qualification which is equivalent or higher than the new qualification

being undertaken will not be eligible for the undergraduate grant or loan. Students MUST apply online via the Education Authority website: www.studentfinancenai.co.uk

4. James Kane Scholarship

The James Kane Foundation is a scholarship award for Higher Education students living within the Armagh, Banbridge and Craigavon Borough Council area. Applications are open to any student from the area beginning a higher education course in select areas**. Each scholarship covers the higher education tuition fee for each successful student for a maximum of two years.

*Accredited courses are those which carry a qualification. A recreational course is not an accredited course.

Big Journeys Begin With Small Steps



In 2023 Southern Regional College signed the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Accord, with the aim of creating real change by encouraging staff, students and the wider community to take personal responsibility to positively change the world around us.

This academic year the College has taken steps to evoke positive change in a number of areas. The wider management team within the College

undertook carbon literacy training, with further plans for this to be rolled out to all staff and students to ensure the College is a fully carbon literate organisation. The College also embarked on a programme to rewild parts of the estates network, aiming to restore natural habitats, enhance biodiversity, and create thriving ecosystems. This initiative involved reducing mowing in designated areas, planting native wildflowers and trees, and allowing natural processes to take the lead. By doing so, we hope to support pollinators, birds and other wildlife and improve soil health. Additionally, these rewilded spaces will offer educational opportunities and tranquil environments for students and staff to connect with nature.

The College has installed new electric vehicle (EV) charging points on the Portadown campus, increasing the overall number of EV charging points

across all campuses and promoting a low-carbon infrastructure. In Newry we've installed photovoltaic solar panels at the East Campus to harness renewable energy to power the campus and cut emissions while also undertaking a major upgrade to the water heating system. This new, energy-efficient system will significantly reduce our carbon footprint and support our ongoing efforts to improve sustainability across all campuses.

Each small step taken contributes to a giant leap in our journey towards a cleaner, greener future! So much so that the College has achieved a Bronze Award in the Business in the Community Environmental Benchmarking Survey! This recognition reflects our ongoing commitment to sustainability and responsible environmental practices.

SRC Earns Autism Advanced Accreditation from National Autistic Society

Southern Regional College's Learning Support Team has received the Autism Advanced Accreditation from the National Autistic Society, the UK's leading charity for autistic people.

The accreditation was given in recognition of the College's continued support for people with autism, enabling everyone to access and advance their educational prospects. As part of the assessment all current students with autism were invited to submit feedback and rate the quality of support and services provided.

Students rated the College positively with 87% of respondents rating SRC as excellent or very good.

This high rating was supported by numerous positive comments submitted to the National Autistic Society.

The recent accreditation follows the College's initial recognition in November 2021, reinforcing the College's commitment to creating a welcoming and inclusive environment.

Assistance from the College's Learning Support team begins as soon as students submit an application, and features orientation visits and links with external transition staff.

Speaking about the accreditation, Donna Hughes, Head of Learning Support at SRC commented: "We are delighted to be recognised by the National Autistic Society for the support and services we provide for our autistic students. This accreditation demonstrates our staff's commitment to making sure all our students receive an education, allowing them to reach their full potential and gain entry to further study or employment."

A Year of Impact: Roundup from the Student Engagement Team



During the past academic year the Student Engagement Team at SRC have delivered a series of impactful initiatives, promoting student wellbeing, inclusion, and community connection across all campuses. The calendar has been jam-packed with activities, too many to highlight, but the few mentioned below gives a flavour of life at SRC!

• Trades Industry Freshers Fair

During Freshers week, we hosted a special event for building and construction apprenticeship and traineeship students on the Greenbank campus. This fair pulled in leading employers from across NI including O'Hanlon & Farrell and Murdock Building Supplies, alongside various health and wellbeing organisations. This year the team worked diligently to address key social issues through forging relevant partnerships with external organisations. The 'We Stand Together' anti-hate training, in collaboration with Policing and Community Safety

Partnerships and Victim Support NI, helped students recognise and know how to report hate crime. This was closely followed by The Rainbow Project led sessions on LGBTQ+ awareness. Our aim is to provide an inclusive environment for all at the College.

During '16 Days of Action Against Gender-Based Violence', we ran workshops with the PSNI and ASSIST NI, helping students understand how to recognise abuse and become active allies. Our Student Engagement Manager also played a pivotal role in the 'Ending Violence Against Women and Girls (EVAWG) Pledge', with plans to introduce bystander training next year.

• Mental Health Support & Initiatives

Mental health support continues to be a central focus at SRC. Through initiatives like Put It in Your Phone Day, supported by Inspire Counselling, we encouraged students to save important support numbers for easy access. In October, we hosted a mental health and resilience residential at East Coast Adventures, where 20 students took part in outdoor activities and workshops to break down mental health barriers and build resilience.

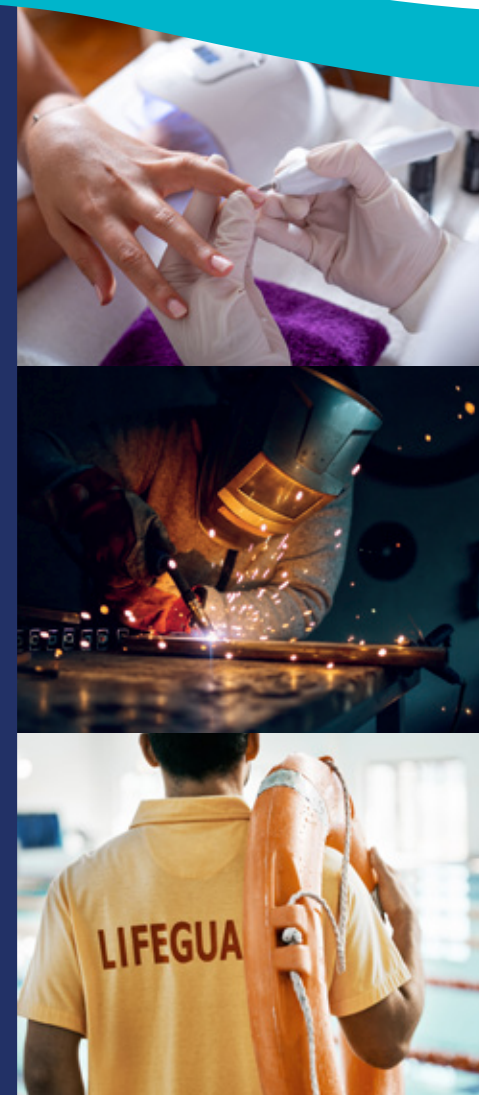

Project Based Learning: 10 Years of Learning By Doing

A successful learner is one who doesn't just learn facts, but one who learns 'how to learn', one who can collaborate, pivot and overcome challenges. At Southern Regional College, our students have been doing just that for the past decade through Project Based Learning (PBL).

PBL is an integral part of all our courses. Each year we challenge our students to identify an issue that has arose through their course of study and start to develop realistic solutions. The Impact of PBL at SRC

Over the past ten years, PBL has become a core teaching method at SRC, with all students required to engage in project work that addresses real-world challenges. This approach has allowed our students to develop essential employability skills such as effective communication, positive teamworking, creative problem-solving, and improved resilience - all skills that employers value highly.

PBL isn't just about completing a project; it's about the process. Students lead the way, with

lecturers providing support and guidance. They collaborate with peers, experts, and external organisations to explore solutions, giving them the chance to practice the skills they'll need in the workplace. By tackling complex, real-life issues, students gain experience in managing timelines, working within budgets, and responding to feedback.

Building Employability Through PBL

Through PBL, students don't just leave College with a certificate - they leave with a portfolio of projects demonstrating their ability to think critically, solve problems and communicate effectively.

Each year, SRC enters students into a sector-wide PBL competition, where students from across NI present their projects to a panel of business experts, gaining valuable feedback from industry professionals. The competition is a chance for students get earn well deserved recognition for their efforts and accomplishments while building self-assurance.

The Road Ahead: Continuing to Innovate

While PBL presents challenges, it also offers immense rewards. Students don't just walk away with knowledge - they walk away with the experience and skills needed to thrive in the real world. At SRC, we will continue to push boundaries, ensuring that our students are not only qualified but ready for the future.
